

CLASS DIVISIONS BY AGE



Each of these classes has their own classroom, paid teacher, and at least one assistant. The teacher will instruct their students in Art, Music, Drama, and PE.



Each age group alternates between separate, paid teachers in Art, Music, Drama, and PE. A permanent assistant is assigned to each group as they travel from class to class.

High School - 14-17



High school students ages 14-17 earn credit in subjects selected yearly. All courses are designed to enhance and further develop skills already being taught at home. This class has one paid teacher and an assistant.

Parent Helpers

Parent involvement is very important to the running of the Academy. All classes, including the Director, will have a sign up sheet for volunteers to help in that area. Each family will need to sign up in at least one area. Families will be contacted by that specific teacher/leader when assistance is needed for that classroom.



Art

Students will receive instruction in fundamental art skills such as patterns, textures, lines, color theory, composition, perspective, etc. Older classes will be involved with more complex projects and advanced art.



Music

All students will receive training in general music theory, instruments, and basic vocal skills. Each age group will also be working on a musical performance in cooperation with the Drama instructor.



Drama

Students will work on basic acting skills including body movement, characterization, and voice projection. They will also be instructed in script writing, casting, directing, line memorization, and improvisation. All age groups will rehearse and perform a special musical/drama production.



PE

Physical Education will include a variety of activities as our students learn the fundamentals of team sports and increase their fitness.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Application

An application must be filled out completely before your family can be considered for enrollment. A registration fee is charged for each family, based on date of registration. All applicants must read and accept the policies in the Home Schoolers' Academy Parent and Student Handbook prior to applying.

Limited enrollment due to space availability may be a determining factor in your acceptance into HSA. An interview may also be required, at the Board's discretion, prior to acceptance.

Registration Fee

\$35.00 per family if paid before August 31
\$45.00 per family if paid on or after September 1
Please send in with your application.

These fees are non-refundable and are not applied toward tuition.

Tuition

1 Child	\$40/month
2 Children	\$60/month
3 Children	\$70/month

Add \$10/month for each additional child.

There will be a \$5 building fee per family, per month.

***Building fee is subject to change without notice, based on the need.

Tuition and building fee are due the first Monday of each month, starting in September and going through May.
